Advocate

- Greater Macomb Project Vox has provided testimony to state lawmakers, in an effort to retain state-funded treatment programs.
- Working closely with the Macomb County Office of Substance Abuse and CARE, Greater Macomb Project Vox participates in transforming the current system of care to one based on the integration of recovery focused services.
- Through letter writing campaigns, members were a large part of helping move parity legislation through the steps necessary to becoming law.
- Greater Macomb Project Vox led the way in obtaining the most signatures on petitions calling for adequate funding for treatment. Michigan policy makers now know that treatment funding should be a priority as they consider budget cuts.



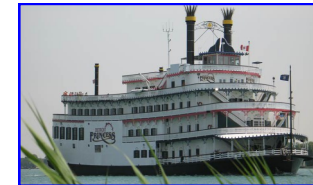
Educate
